

## **SESC Plan Requirements:**

Pursuant to Rule 1703 promulgated under Part 91, all SESC plans must contain at a minimum, the following information:

*Map (plan) with a scaled drawing of not more than 200 feet to the inch (or as required by the county or municipal enforcing agency) that includes:*

- A site location sketch
- The proximity of the proposed earth change to lakes and streams;
- Predominant land features; and
- Contour intervals or slope description

*Soil survey or written description of the soils of the anticipated exposed land area.*

*Details of the proposed earth change including:*

- A description of the location of the physical limits of each proposed earth change;
- A description and the location of all existing and proposed on-site drainage and dewatering facilities;
- The timing and sequence of each proposed earth change;
- The location and description for installing and removing all proposed temporary SESC measures;
- The description and the location all proposed permanent SESC measures;
- A program proposal for the continued maintenance of all permanent SESC measures, including the person responsible for the maintenance.

*Any other information required by the part 91 agency that has jurisdiction over the project.*
